Application Guide for Privately funded International Students Planning to Enroll in the Doctoral Program

How to Apply for Admission/Tuition Fee Deferments

The admission fee deferment system allows for the extension of the payment deadline to a specified period. The tuition fee deferment system includes 'extended payment' and 'monthly installment payment.' 'Extended payment' allows for the extension of the payment deadline to a specified period, while 'monthly installment payment' allows for the payment of half-term tuition fees in monthly installments.

Privately funded international students enrolling in the doctoral program who wish to apply for admission or tuition fee deferments should submit the application and other necessary documents during the entrance process.
